Rules & Regulations

Participants are requested to carefully read all rules governing this show. Competition rules will follow the Saskatchewan Horse Federation Rule book.

Everyone mounted on a horse must wear approved ASTM/SEI Certified helmets in **ALL** classes as well as anywhere on the grounds.

Must present a **2024 negative coggins test** for each horse entered in the show.

Any questions or concerns should be brought to the Show Mangers (Cindy & Terry Klassen).

Entries close Mondays May 20th to avoid a \$25.00 late charge.

Numbers are to be worn in such a way that they are easily visible to the judge. If you need show numbers, we will provide you with your own set of bridle number for \$15.00. You must pre-order.

Cancellation of entries after closing date shall forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified medical doctor or veterinarian is presented to the show office before the start of classes. Office administration fee will be retained on all cancellations.

Must have a current SHF membership.

The Saskatchewan Horse Federation works towards achieving the following objectives:

- To provide leadership among recognized equine and equestrian organizations in Saskatchewan that each may be helped to achieve the highest level of success for its members.
- To co-ordinate the activities of the recognized equine and equestrian organizations in Saskatchewan so that duplication of effort and conflict of purpose may be avoided.
- To provide liaison with similar provincial equine councils, and with the Coaching Association of Canada, with the Horse Welfare Alliance of Canada, with Equine Canada, and with any other related national body as may exist for the conduct of sport, recreation and horse industry initiatives in Canada.
- To serve as an educational medium for its members by distributing information relative to the horse industry and equestrian activities by bringing speakers of authority to meetings of the Federation, and by organizing seminars and clinics.
- To develop and deliver programs and projects as appropriate to advance the needs and interests of the membership.
- To serve as a medium through which the provincial government and other agencies may make funds available to support equine and equestrian organizations and activities in Saskatchewan.
- To raise the standards of care and handling of all horses in Saskatchewan.

To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals, you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible.

Saskatchewan Hunter Jumper Association

The goal of the Saskatchewan Hunter Jumper Association is to provide a strong support system for riders interested in the sport of show jumping and hunters. To enable and encourage all riders to compete at horse shows where hunter and jumper competitions are available. In order to achieve these goals, the SHJA will provide education, horse shows, and clinicians available to all levels of hunter and jumper riders in Saskatchewan.

YOUR Membership gives you:

GRASSROOTS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS – programs available to accumulate points for year-end awards.

MEDAL COMPETITIONS - equitation classes sponsored by the SHJA.

GRASSROOTS CLINICS – clinics with a focus on beginner riders, adult and children, interested in riding over fences.

COMPETITIVE CLINICS - clinics focused on riders already competing at hunter jumper horse shows.

AUDITING OF CLINICS – an opportunity for members to listen and observe any clinics throughout the membership year which the SHJA is hosting.

Membership is open to all individuals interested in horses, horse sports, or the horse industry, organized groups of equestrians including horse breeders, trainers, horsemen's clubs, pony clubs. Membership is also open to those individuals or organizations willing to sponsor competitions and other events.

Stabling: Every horse/pony entered in the show must have a stall. A cheque for \$50 must accompany entry as a stall cleaning fee. These cheques will only be cashed if the stall has not been cleaned at the end of the show.

TALLY HO EQUESTRIAN, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees, nor representatives of the Show Committee will not be held responsible in any way for damage, injury or loss to persons, horses, tack, property, spectators or exhibitors. **Please sign the Acceptance of Risk form and return with entry form and fees.**

The show committee reserves the right to cancel, split or combine any classes.

Open schooling rounds will be held from 12:00pm to 7:00 pm Fridays of each show. Coaches wishing to book time may do so by Thursdays of each show by contacting Cindy Klassen. There will be opening schooling available Saturday 6:30am – 7:45am for \$25 and No schooling on Sunday.

Stallions may NOT be ridden by juniors.

Braiding is optional.

A horse/rider combination may compete in a maximum of 3 consecutive heights per day; a horse may compete in a maximum of four over fences classes per day which applies to combined Hunter and Jumper classes including specials, classics, derby's, medals, or equitation over fence (not including Hunter warmups, Jumper clear-rounds and hors concours rounds). Specials & Classics that require two rounds are only counted as 1.

Horses must be entered and shown in the hunter class over fences in order to compete in the corresponding under saddle class, class.

Equitation over fences will be ridden at the highest height competed at the show to a maximum of height of 2'6.

Entry fees: All classes - \$25

Prizes: Ribbons to 5th place in all classes.
